BIDS WILL BE OPENED AT 12 NOON, BRISTOL TOWN HALL, 10 COURT STREET ON FEBRUARY 22, 2012 FOR THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING OF FEBRUARY 29, 2012.

Bid documents may be obtained starting Friday, January 20, 2012 for a non-refundable fee of \$75 and bids MUST be filed at the Office of the Town Clerk, 10 Court Street, Bristol, RI 02809. Bid documents may also be examined, but not obtained during regular business hours, at the office of Dodge Reports, 34 Crosby Drive, Bedford, Massachusetts. Bids must be sealed and clearly marked on the outside with the subject matter, bid number, and the bidding date. Bids will be opened at 12 noon at the Bristol Town Hall, 10 Court Street on February 22, 2012. Successful bidders must furnish a performance bond on 100 percent of the proposed contract within 15 days after the award. The Town Council reserves all rights to reject any and all bids, or any part thereof, or to go on the open market when is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.

Any contract or contracts awarded under the Advertisement for Bids will be funded in part by a grant from the U.S. Department of Commerce - Economic Development Administration (EDA). The total amount of federal funding included in the project financing will be \$2,960,320 which represents a portion of the total project costs to include design, construction, project inspection and management of the project. Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this advertisement or any resulting contract.

Attention of Bidders is particularly referred to the Federal and State requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and wage rates to be paid under the Contract as determined by the Department of Labor and Industries under the provision of Chapters 12 and 13 of Title 37, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended.

The Bidders attention is also called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause", the "Nondiscrimination in Employment", and the Federal and State MBE/WBE requirements of the Contract.

Bidder's shall be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and State of Rhode Island Executive Order No. 85-11, as amended.

This project is also subject to Chapter 37-14.1 of the Rhode Island General Laws, and regulations, which require that ten percent (10%) of the dollar value of the work performed on the project, be performed by certified minority business enterprises.
