Tax Sales- Bristol, RI

The Town of Bristol, RI holds tax sales annually. The exact date and time depend on workloads and scheduling, however, normal practice is to hold the sale between the dates of April 1, and July 31. Tax Sales are always held at the Town Hall. Interested parties are welcome to inquire after March 31 via the Finance Department (401-253-7000) regarding known scheduling.

Properties to be included are advertised in accordance with RIGL Chapter 44-9 in the Town's local paper, the Bristol Phoenix. Rhode Island General Laws (RIGL) are available over the internet (<http://www.rilin.state.ri.us/Statutes>), major RI public libraries, or most Town Clerk offices.

Tax Sale procedures in Rhode Island are established by the above referenced law.

Payment for tax titles purchased must be made immediately following the sale by cash or certified check.

Properties purchased by the Town (historically a rare occurrence) are advertised and available at the next tax sale.
